## 1. What it is

- Australian jurisdiction for XBRL International Inc (XII)
  - Pays membership fee to XII
  - Seat on Steering Committee to represent views of Australian members
  - Founding member of XII – since 2001
- Not-for-Profit, Limited by Guarantee
- Funded by Member Subscriptions and the occasional Government Grant
- Controlled by Board of Directors:
  - ASX Representative (Paul Phenix)
  - Academic (Jim Richards – ex-Murdoch Uni)
  - Consultant (Trevor Pyman – self, PwC, SKM, TS)
  - Advisory Board (Sponsor Member nominees)
- Local access point to XBRL International network



## 2. What it offers

- Access to XII Working Groups – Specification, Versioning, XBRL GL, Rendering, Assurance, Public Sector (forming).
  - Participation in development
  - Documents, presentations, webcasts and other files
  - Network of expert contacts – a wealth of free advice
- Free/discounted entry to XBRL Australia workshops and seminars, discounted entry to XII Conferences
- A voice on the governing body to influence direction and priorities, both locally and internationally, for the evolution of the XBRL standard
- Up to date news/information on XBRL developments in Australia and overseas
- Recognition as a participant in the future of business reporting in Australia

## 3. What members can expect
