

PRSANZ Travel Grants for Young Researchers

The Paediatric Research Society of Australia and New Zealand (PRSANZ) is offering a number of travel grants to assist young researchers to attend the 2008 RACP Congress in Adelaide in May.

To be eligible you must:

- be actively involved in *paediatric* research (clinical or laboratory based)
- have an abstract accepted for the RACP Congress or be invited to speak
- be at an early stage of your research career, ie. a paediatric advanced trainee; enrolled in a PhD; a post-doctoral fellow working in a laboratory
- be a paid member of the PRSANZ (membership fee is \$30 and application forms can be obtained by emailing elizabe2@chw.edu.au)

The following documentation is required to be submitted:

1. a *brief* curriculum vitae including details of your *research experience* and *current funding*,
2. a copy of the abstract, and
3. proof of acceptance of the abstract or invitation to speak
