The WMCR based on WPCS

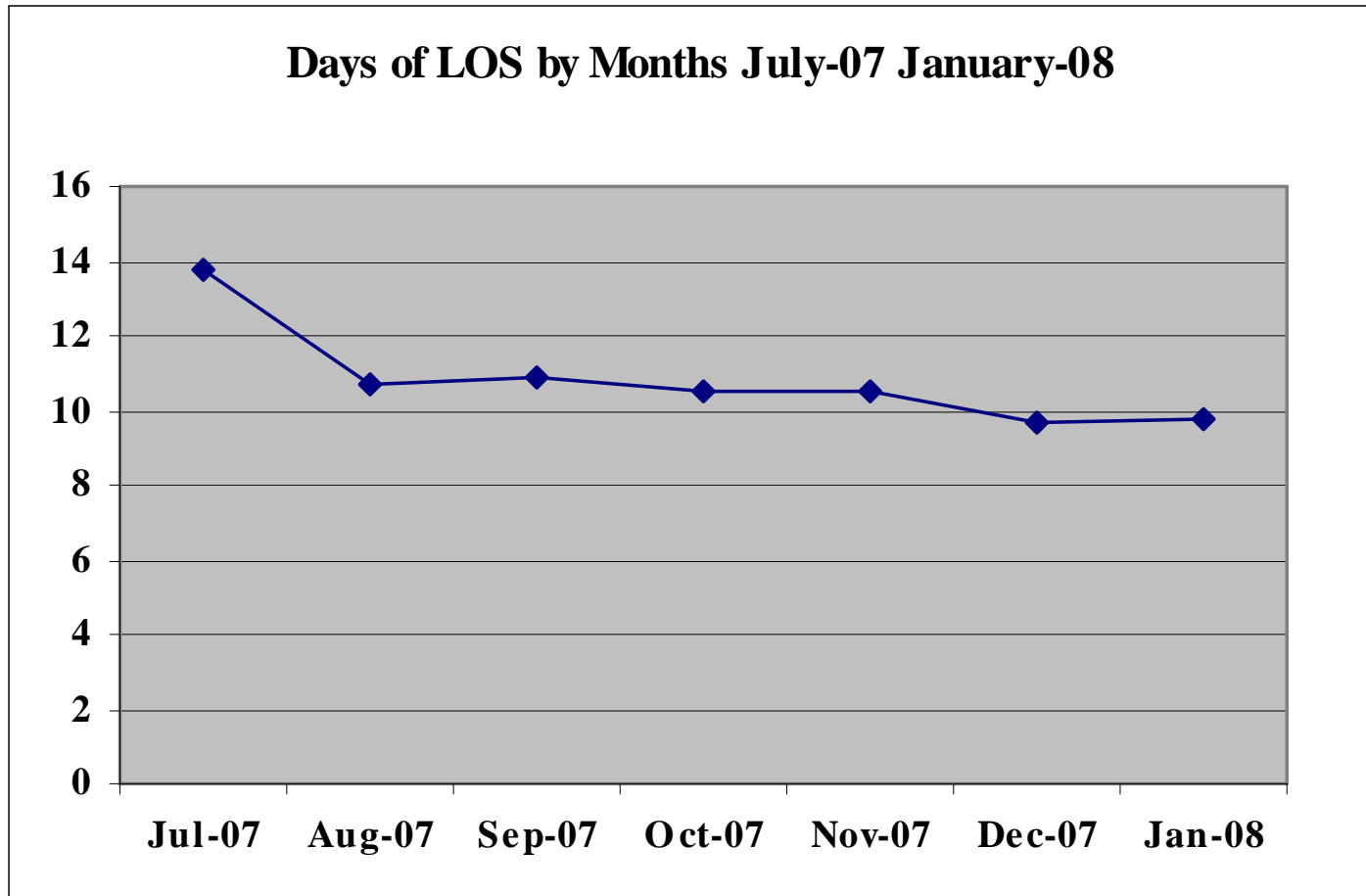
- **After the WMCR the WPCS updates are emailed to all the members.**
- **The planning process based on the WMCR facilitates Discharge planning for all clinicians.**
- **Discharge Summary is prepared with Consultants' active input and supervision.**

The WMCR based on WPCS

- **Team Work & Optimal Communication.**
- **Nurses discussed concerns with Physicians.**
- **Nurse Manager use WMCR for other ward topics.**
- **The Medication Chart is completed by the Pharmacist.**
- **Pharmacists have active participation. In “Medication-Reconciliation” and “Des-Prescribing” .**

The WMCR Impact in LOS

The average LOS was reduced from 13.8 days in July 2007 to 9.8 days in January 2008.
